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Information for Candidates

for Town of Normal Board of Trustees (Councilmembers)

This document contains information regarding the 2023 Consolidated Election for the Town of Normal. **This document is not legal advice.** State law prohibits the Town Clerk from providing legal assistance or answering questions pertaining to specific election laws. All candidates and other interested parties are encouraged to obtain their own legal counsel if they have any questions or concerns about the election laws and procedures.

Offices for Election

Three Trustees will be elected for a Four-Year Term, which will expire in April 2027. The election is a nonpartisan election, and the Board of Trustees are elected at large.

Documents to be Filed

To appear on the ballot, a candidate must file the following documents with the Town Clerk:

- **Receipt from County Clerk for filing Statement of Economic Interest.** This Statement must be filed with the County Clerk before the Nomination Petition is filed with the Town Clerk. Failure to do so will result in a delay in the petition filing and may result in the candidate's name not appearing on the ballot.
- **Nonpartisan Petition for Nomination.** A copy is attached. You will need to make additional copies as needed. The petitions should be notarized, and each page numbered.
- **Statement of Candidacy.** A copy is attached.
- **Loyalty Oath.** Filing this document is optional. A copy is attached.

Where to File

All petitions must be filed in the office of the Town Clerk, City Hall, Second Floor Uptown Station, 11 Uptown Circle, Normal, McLean County, Illinois between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00p.m., prevailing time.

When to File

The time for filing is November 21, 2022 thru November 28, 2022.

Number of Petition Signatures Required

Under the Election Code the signature requirement for non-partisan elections is the same as for independent candidates in partisan elections (10 ILCS 5/10-3.1) The signature requirement for independent candidates is at least 5% but not more than 8% of the voters in the last municipal election (10 ILCS 5/10-3). According to the County Clerk, in the 2021 Municipal Election there were #### ballots cast, which included the office of Board of Trustees.

Election Calendar

August 30, 2022	First date to circulate petitions for Primary Election.
November ##, 2022	Pre-Filing Notice Published.
November 21-28, 2022	Filing Period for February 28, 2023, Consolidated Primary Election. (A Primary is held only if the number of candidates for office totals more than four times the number to be elected for any office.) Consolidated Election is April 4, 2023. Nominating petitions are filed with the local election official (Municipal Clerk). Nomination papers include the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Statement of Candidacy.2. Nomination Petition Sheets.3. Receipt for filing a Statement of Economic Interest.4. Loyalty Oath (optional).

SIMULTANEOUS PETITION FILING – LOTTERY:

All petitions filed by individuals waiting in line at the office of the local election official (City Clerk) as of 8:30 a.m. on the first day of filing (November 21, 2022) are considered simultaneous filings. Petitions filed by mail and received in the office of the local election official in the first mail delivery on the first day of filing are also considered simultaneous filings. All petitions received thereafter are filed in the order of actual receipt. If two or more petitions are filed within the last hour of the filing deadline, they shall be deemed as being simultaneously filed and are included in the lottery drawing to determine the final ballot position.

In the event of simultaneously filed petitions, a lottery must be held within nine (9) days after the last day of the petition filing period.

<i>November 30, 2022</i>	Written notice of the date, time, and place of the lottery to the candidates given by local election official.
<i>December 7, 2022</i>	Lottery (if necessary).
	The dates for written notice and lottery are subject to change. The lottery is conducted within nine (9) days after the last day of the petition filing period, but seven (7) days written notice must be given.
<i>December ##, 2022</i>	Last day for local election official to receive objections to nomination petitions.
<i>December ##, 2022</i>	Last day to certify names of candidates to the County Clerk.
<i>February 28, 2023</i>	Consolidated Primary Election.
	Primary Election held ONLY if 13 people file petitions for three Council positions and/or 5 people file petitions for Mayor.
<i>April 4, 2023</i>	Consolidated Election.
